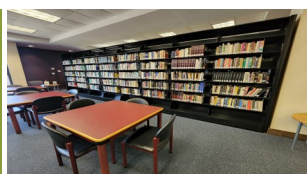
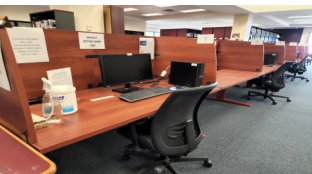

## Library Policy

- ◆ No food or drinks.

## Computer Use Policy

- ◆ Use CAC to login.
- ◆ Properly log out of the computer when no longer in use. *(Removing your CAC is not properly logging out of the computer.)*
- ◆ Do not connect any external devices to PC such as thumb drives or external hard drives.
- ◆ Do not use PC's external ports to charge other devices.

## Circulation Policy

- ◆ One month checkout on books, DVDs, and audio material.
- ◆ In accordance with AR 735-17, patrons are required to replace lost or stolen items.
- ◆ A hold will be placed on the item if a patron desires the item in question.
- ◆ Overnight check out of reference material.
- ◆ Renewals are available on most materials.
